### **Isaiah House recognized**

HUSTONVILLE - The Acton Institute of Michigan Samaritans Guide has picked the Isaiah House as Kentucky's best, and the top 14 in the Southeast, which contains 250 other nonprofits.

Isaiah House is a long-term live-in Christian drug and alcohol recovery center located in Lincoln County that houses up to 20 men for recovery. It is entering its sixth year. The Isaiah House received an excellent rating, which is the best possible rating. This is the fourth consecutive year Isaiah House has received the recognition, according to Mark LaPalme, who operates the house.

The organization partially is funded by several area churches including Southside Christian, Parlor Grove Baptist, Southern Heights Baptist, New Beginnings Community Church, Cornerstone Assembly of God, Lincoln County Baptist, Grace Fellowship, Fairview Baptist and the Kentucky Baptist Association as well as private donations.
